

MedInvent, LLC announces publication of the first clinical data regarding the NasoNeb Nasal Nebulizer

October 31, 2011: White Bear Lake, MN. MedInvent, LLC announced today the publication of the study **Manes RP, Tong L, Batra PS.: “Prospective evaluation of aerosol delivery by a powered nasal nebulizer in the cadaver model” Int Forum Allergy Rhinol, 2011; 1:366–371.** The first peer-reviewed paper reports the results of a trial that demonstrates the ability of the NasoNeb Nasal Nebulizer to deposit medication throughout the intranasal and paranasal sinus cavity and examined the deposition in the un-operated nose and operated nose.

Dr. Raj Sindwani, of Cleveland, Ohio, who did not participate in the study, stated “The results of this study are exciting as they demonstrate the ability of the NasoNeb Nasal Nebulizer to reach the whole nasal and paranasal sinus cavities with a high concentration of medication following surgery.” He added: “Our ability to access the interior of sinus cavities and directly target diseased mucosa with topical drug delivery is a very promising approach to treating patients with chronic rhinosinusitis.”

William Flickinger, Managing Partner at MedInvent, LLC noted: “We believe the results of this study correlate with the clinical reports we are hearing from otolaryngologists and allergists treating patients with the NasoNeb Nasal Nebulizer. We will continue to help advance patient care by funding studies to investigate the clinical impact of topical therapies delivered via the NasoNeb Nasal Nebulizer.”
